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The Issue

With the Localism Bill extending a Community Right to Build across England (rather than just in rural areas), and the New Homes Bonus offering cash to councils who allow new homes to be built in their areas, new planning applications are increasingly likely to affect the surrounding area of a property.

On average, 50-60% of housing land comes from windfall developments. There are still huge areas of land yet to be developed and, in light of a chronic national housing shortage, the need is expected to increase further over the next few years. The plan on the right is representative of most urban areas in the country: the orange coloured land could be built upon under current and national planning policy.



Planning implications are increasingly on the agenda for homebuyers – **93% of homeowners consider information on large planning applications in the local area of a house purchase as important¹ and only 50% of people would welcome more homes of all types in their own immediate neighbourhood².**

As clients become more aware of development risk as an issue, solicitors need to know how to obtain further information to address their concerns; local authority searches are mainly restricted to planning applications on the property itself, with planning searches usually restricted to current and historic planning information in the area.
